2016 Pinot Noir

Spanish Springs Vineyard, San Luis Obispo County
Aromatically, this unctuous Pinot Noir is driven with black and red fruits laden with spice and French oak notes. The palate is rich, with alluring vibrant acidity. The flavor profile consists of dark raspberry, cinnamon, with a sweet oaky finish. Pair this lovely Pinot Noir with roast or grilled pork dishes or kick back with casual BBQ.

2022 Red Handed

50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 25% Petit Verdot, 17% Malbec, 8% Cabernet Franc, Central Coast

Tinted to a velvety purple like inky dragon's blood, this wine opens with a nose of black cherry, graphite and cassis. A dry but buzzy mouthfeel yields to the fruitiness of blackberry and prunes coupled with a long finish of green pepper, tobacco and black licorice. Use this wine for hors d' oeuvres of Toscano cheese, pepperoni and crackers before a meal of smoked BBQ beef ribs or Italian meatballs in marinara.

2018 Cabernet Sauvignon - Reserve

Paso Robles

Our 2018 Cabernet opens with a big bouquet of cedar, red roses, and incense. It has a delicious full-bodied mouthfeel with bright, intense flavors of pomegranate, raspberries and cranberry. This reserve Cab has the longest, most satisfying finish of the three in the 2018 vintage, imparting a satisfying, soothing, and complexity of flavors. This robust wine will pair well with prime rib and garlic grilled asparagus.

2016 Cabernet Franc

Paso Robles

Vintage after vintage Plummer Vineyard in Paso Robles reliably exhibits aromas of chocolate and blackberry. Aromas of leather and pepper with flavors of licorice, lavender and blackberry. Pair with honey-glazed beef short ribs, barbacoa tacos or pork chops with jammy mustard glaze.



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
